WASP COMMUNITY BUS

Extract from the minutes of the Annual General Meeting - 31/3/22

The Chairman reported:

"2020/21 has again been difficult but I am are pleased that the WASP Bus has managed to operate through the year with most if not all of the regular shopping runs completed. My thanks to all the drivers as well as the trustee directors.

Particular thanks should go to Alan Halder, our treasurer / secretary; to Chris Dews, for looking after the maintenance issues; and to Soo Dean who has managed the bookings so efficiently. Soo is moving away so we are very pleased to welcome to Rachel Dews who has taken over Soo's role.

Our thanks to Shere Parish Council who have donated £1000 towards the Bus funds and to both Surrey and West Sussex County Councils who have continued to support the regular shopping runs.

Thanks must go the Gomshall Club for allowing us to park behind their premises, this is working well and we are very grateful that they have made us so welcome.

The shopping runs to Sainsburys at Godalming, to Cranleigh and to Tesco at Broadbridge Heath have continued through the year with the added interest of Lidl in Guildford as an alternative to Sainsbury. We have followed, to the best of our ability, the rules & regulations around covid.

There are signs that local groups are beginning to think about using the bus for trips, but this will take some time to get back to pre-pandemic levels.

The accounts showed a fairly constant cash balance which reflects the fact that income covers the running costs, but does not provide cash for any future replacement of the bus. This is very similar to the position in the previous year and is not sustainable indefinitely."

NEWS FROM THE BELFRY

Ringing for The Platinum Jubilee

The Jubilee celebrations went in a blur of bell ringing events for a lot of us. There was a national ring at 11.30 on the day of the service at St Paul's in which both Capel and Ockley churches



took part.

We also managed to ring quarter peals at all of the local churches in the Jubilee week - Capel, Newdigate and Ockley - as part of the Surrey Association event to ring quarters at all their towers. Congratulations to Jo who rang her first quarter on the treble, at her first attempt, at Newdigate, followed 2 days later by her second at Ockley!

The bells at St Margaret's are twice as heavy as at Newdigate and so we do not often ring quarters and this one, by our local band was quite an achievement. We have a new recruit who learnt to ring at Leigh in the 1980's and his father, also a ringer, was visiting from Australia and helped us greatly, particularly by ringing in the quarters at Capel and Ockley.

The definition of a peal comes from the number of permutations in the order in which the bells can be rung, in an 8 bell tower with the tenor staying at the back, of 5040 changes, which takes about 3 hours to ring. They are most usually rung to mark special occasions and in former days, long before television and radio, the attempt would be advertised in the newspapers and attract many spectators.

It is more common these days, and more easily achievable, to ring a quarter (of a peal), of 1260 changes, which takes about 45 minutes, and causes less disturbance to the neighbours. We often ring shorter lengths known as touches, so ringing the entire piece is not such a great step but even so it is much more demanding to concentrate for the longer time, and stay focused on your place within the method.

A method is a ringing pattern determined by the blue line in a diagram which everyone on an inside, or working bell, has to learn, along with the rules to follow when a call is made. Ringing a plain course takes just over a minute and varying this by calling a 'Bob' or 'Single' leads to the same work being repeated with some of the bells in a different order to eventually make the 1260 changes required

Campanology, as bellringing is more formally known, is very rewarding, combining a physical and social activity with the mental exercise of keeping your bell in the right place. Once you are capable of handling a bell independently and able to strike it accurately you can visit almost any set

of bells and become a valued member of the band. Practice nights are on Wednesdays from 7.45 to 9.15, and anyone is welcome to come along and watch or have a go, under supervision.

Issues raised by parishioners are always considered carefully by councillors.

Their local knowledge is invaluable. However District and County Councils may also become involved bringing additional skills with them to help to sort out these issues.

The Annual Assembly and Annual Meeting of Ockley Parish Council were held at the beginning of May.

The Chairman had prepared a report for the Annual Assembly and this can be seen on the parish council website.

At the Annual Meeting Dick Thomas was re-elected as Chairman and Jo Page as Vice-Chairman. Parish councillors are Amanda Barclay, James Lee-Steere, Jo Page, Dick Thomas, Barry Thorne and Zoe Ward. There is still a vacancy for a councillor. Many thanks to councillors for continuing to carry out a considerable amount of voluntary work on behalf of the community.

Other points of note:

- strimming around The Green thank you to the parishioner who has kept this area tidy for a number of
 years. The time he has spent doing this on a voluntary basis has been very much appreciated.
- footpaths in the parish a number of stiles have been identified that need work done on them / need replacement. Work will continue to be carried out on this project.
- work is also continuing on the Ockley Neighbourhood Development Plan your responses and
 comments on the survey will all be followed up. A section on the NDP is to be included on the parish
 council website so all information will be readily available for parishioners to view.
- the team taking plans forward for the Community Hub project have also been busy the project will need to be funded by a grant from SCC. There is a separate website for this project: https://www.ockleyhub.com/.
- play area at the village hall the borders around the barked areas are to be renewed. Repairs are to be carried out on the fence around the play area. Please help to look after this valuable village asset as some parts have been damaged over the past few months.
- parish council meetings are held face to face. Please look at the parish council website for up to date information regarding these meetings. Remaining meeting dates for 2022 are 4 July, 5 September and 7 November. Parishioners are always welcome to attend meetings.



THE GARDEN IN JULY AND AUGUST

We Brits do like our irony and there is something very British in the fact that whilst the Summer Solstice in late June (21st this year) celebrates the official start of summer, it is also our longest day, and heralds the drawing in of days!


So there is NO excuse not to live our British summer life to its full in July and August. Staycations may well be on the cards for many this year so do use the weekends and holidays to enjoy lazy, sunshiney days and warm evenings relaxing in our gardens; games and picnics in the park; village cricket on the green; trips to the seaside with fish and chips; and cream teas at village fairs.

And whilst our gardens in May and June are more colourfully exuberant and 'upright' – as we move through July to August, 'faded grandeur' and 'unruly' spring to mind! But beautiful still in a wilder way. There are still numerous plants adding lots of colour and height interest to our gardens including Achillea, Echinacea, Verbena Bonariensis (means 'good for nothing!'), Echinops Scabious, Leucanthemum and of course, the wonderful varieties of Phlox. Plus the many 'cut flower' annuals that you can add to your borders in May such as Zinnia, Antirrhinum and Nicotiana. Various 'repeat

flowering' roses will continue to bloom through to autumn if they're looked after. Keep deadheading, watering and feeding them, particularly if they're in pots. Later-planted sweet peas should still be looking good if you cut them regularly (to stop them setting seed). And this is also the time when pots and hanging baskets give that extra vibrancy to our outside spaces; the bright reds, lipstick pinks, corals and lilacs of pelargonium, begonia and



verbena; the blousy petunias; those honey-scented nemesia; and the trailing colourful stems of lobelia, bacopa and fuchsia. Mixing small shrubs and perennials with annuals can add interest to your pots. And it's often best to buy the biggest pot you can afford, even if you have a small space. They won't dry out so quickly and they provide impact and structure. Why not try a centrepiece in a large pot - such as hydrangea paniculata 'Vanilla Fraise' - for year round

structure, then base plant with small spring bulbs in the autumn, then bedding plants for summer through to autumn?

In the vegetable department, aim to water on a regular basis, particularly your tomatoes, consistently feeding them once a week. Also don't forget to stop cordon tomatoes by removing the main shoot. Look for the leaf that's above the fourth truss (set of developing fruit) and cut it off here. This should ensure that all the fruits ripen by the end of the season. Bush tomatoes can be left to their own devices.



Your first early Potatoes should be ready to harvest soon along with Spinach, Peas and Beans, Carrots, Salads and spring planted Onion and Garlic. Consider sowing spring cabbage, leeks and brassicas for a winter supply. Summer prune gooseberries and redcurrants.

And finally... the Okewood Ockley and Forest Green Summer Fair is on Saturday 13th August. This is the first one since 2019 and it's fantastic to see it back. There's fun for all the family with music and Morris Dancing; Classic Cars; a Kids Zone; and craft demonstrations. Check out the plant stalls and the various vegetable exhibits in the Marquee for some inspiration! You might even think about exhibiting your own fruit, veg or flowers yourself (a schedule and entry form should have been delivered to your door in June). See you there!

FIELD ARCHERY Vs. TARGET ARCHERY

We at Team Sagittarius enjoy the sport of archery and promote this relaxing and fun pastime suitable for the whole family.

Target Archery. Is the form that most folks recognise, with it being in the Olympics, shooting recurve bows with stabilisers, sights carbon or aluminium, arrows with plastic vanes for flights etc. There are many target clubs around. Usually you will find target archers shooting rounds of arrows up to 70 yards at standard bullseye style paper faces with colours of yellow, red, blue, black and white in a pleasant setting of cut grass pasture. On pleasant days the twang of bow strings and the zing of arrows are almost as common place as the sound of leather on willow. Fun for all the family who enjoy a very civilised day out.

Field Archery. This style of archery is more for the traditional of mind, set in rustic woodlands up and down the country the call of the wild can be strong when one is experiencing the thump of a heavy wooden arrow hitting its mark. 
